

## Daniil Antropov

Daniil Antropov, Artist (b. 1991, Vladivostok). Lives and works in Moscow. Graduated from the Far Eastern State Institute of Arts (Vladivostok, 2013) and the "Free Workshops" School of Contemporary Art (Moscow, 2018). Participated in many group exhibitions, including the Vladivostok Biennale of Visual Arts (Vladivostok, 2009), Tokyo Design Week (Tokyo, 2010), "Decorative Spirit" (Yangtze, China, 2012), "Konstantin Grebnev, Daniil Antropov. Devoid Forms" (Moscow, 2019). Daniil explores the subjects of consumerism and industrial manufacturing. In his pieces made from ceramic and industrial detritus, the artist combines modern media with traditional ones to bring out the alternative properties of each material.
