

Dmitriy Lukanin

Dmitry Lukanin was born in Moscow in 1967 in the family of the painter Nikolai Aleksandrovich Lukanin. Has attended several art schools and studios of Fine Arts in childhood. In 1985 he entered the «Moscow Art School in memory of 1905», but was drafted into the army in the same year. Thereby he graduated from the Art School only in 1991. In 1997 he graduated from the Department of Monumental Painting at the V. Surikov Moscow State Academy. Same year he joined the Russian Union of Artists and became a member of the Moscow Union of Artists.

Currently Dmitry Lukanin lives and works in Moscow as the main artist-decorator in the art bureau «Palmette» which was founded by him in 2005 and is specialized in interior decoration. Member of the art-group "Russia" since its inception.

About the group "Russia":

"The reference to the old masters is not the goal of the artists of the «Russia» group. It is important for them to keep the entire history of the development of art in their minds, rather than be on the ecstatic edge of the vector of this development" - S. Anufriev

The group "Russia" consists of the Blok-Dmitriev family (Ivan Dmitriev, Lyudmila Blok, Egor Dmitriev) and their close friend, Dmitriy Lukanin. The canvases of the group represent the junction of realism and classicism or, as described by Elena Selina, made "between schematism and hyperrealism". The group carried out several art projects and held a number of exhibitions in collaboration with various artists. It worked with the group "Medical Hermeneutics", as well as separately with Pavel Pepperstein, Sergey Anufriev and several representatives of Neo-Academism.
